### To be eligible\*, all applicants must...

- 1. Be an MIT Federal Credit Union member in good standing or the child of an MIT Federal Credit Union member in good standing.
- 2. Be least 18 years old.
- 3. Complete this scholarship entry form.
- 4. Submit an official cumulative transcript.\*\*
- 5. Be a rising college freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior, and be enrolled or will be enrolled full-time in an undergraduate degree program at an accredited college or university during the **2024-2025 academic year**.
- 6. Submit a typewritten essay of 300-400 words in reponse to the essay question.

Due to the sensitive information we ask for on the Memorial Scholarship Application, if you plan on emailing your submission, please password-protect the PDF before emailing it and call us or send a separate email with the password.

Winners will be notified in April. An awards presentation will take place at our annual business meeting on Thursday, April 25, 2024.

- \* Past winners and MIT FCU employees, volunteers, and their family members are not eligible.
- \*\* Transcripts must be in a sealed envelope from your school. Photocopies, faxes, and online printouts are not permitted. Please note that transcripts will not be returned.
