Recipients are selected based on essay content, grades, financial need, and extracurricular/community activities.

To be eligible*, all applicants must...

1. Be an MIT Federal Credit Union member in good standing or the child of an MIT Federal Credit Union member in good standing.
2. Be at least 18 years old.
3. Complete this scholarship entry form.
4. Submit an official cumulative transcript.**
5. Be a rising college freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior, and be enrolled or will be enrolled full-time in an undergraduate degree program at an accredited college or university during the **2024-2025 academic year**.
6. Submit a typewritten essay of 300-400 words in response to the essay question.

Due to the sensitive information we ask for on the Memorial Scholarship Application, if you plan on emailing your submission, please password-protect the PDF before emailing it and call us or send a separate email with the password.

Winners will be notified in April. An awards presentation will take place at our annual business meeting on Thursday, April 25, 2024.

* Past winners and MIT FCU employees, volunteers, and their family members are not eligible.

** Transcripts must be in a sealed envelope from your school. Photocopies, faxes, and online printouts are not permitted. Please note that transcripts will not be returned.
